

**INVOAD Tree Debris Removal / Cleanup Days for Recent Tornadoes / Storms  
Info dated 6-5-08, 5:30pm**

**MOSCOW in Rush County– FRI - /SAT – June 6-7, 9am-whenever**

Need AFFILIATED volunteer groups as well as UNAFFILIATED COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS with chain saws, skidsters (Bobcats/front end loaders) and laborers to move tree debris to curbside.

Pastor Mike Riggs at Moscow Christian Church is point contact for church location, cell 765-561-3499.

Because of tremendous debris and extremely narrow roads, volunteers **must park at the Quarry** at SR 244 between CR 500 and 600. Volunteers will be shuttled into town by bus. A truck will take chainsaws. Hoping for total of 200 volunteers between chainsaws and debris removal. Cut big limbs to 4 feet. Salvation Army will shuttle food from the church.

Volunteers will be asked to sign volunteer release forms.

Notes for Clients: The volunteers will present themselves as volunteers from INVOAD or affiliated churches or disaster teams such as HCRN, Southern Baptists, Friends, MDS or UMCOR. They will ask the homeowner to sign a release to work on the property. The service is FREE. Please BE AWARE of anyone offering to provide the service for a fee.

Coordinated efforts for both local farmers (Dean Bacon, 765-969-8285 for farmers) and dwellings (Pastor Riggs for homeowners, 765-561-3499). Focus on Friday is dwellings in Moscow. Southern Baptist and HCRN and Amish crew are planning to attend. Kevin Cox of HCRN is on the ground with questions. DO NOT GIVE THESE NUMBERS TO CLIENTS. **MIDDLETOWN (Note there are 2 Middletowns in Indiana- this is the one in Shelby County near Waldron)– SAT, JUNE 7 ONLY, 8am-3**

Need AFFILIATED volunteer groups as well as UNAFFILIATED COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS with chain saws, skidsters (Bobcats/front end loaders) and laborers to move tree debris to curbside.

All the work will focus on main road known as East Michigan. **Meet at Waldron High School.** Lots of debris in town and about 18 homes damages. Haul debris to roadside for state to pick up. Cut big limbs to 4 feet. Salvation Army will provide the Frankfort canteen Saturday. Hoping to get power and water restored soon.

Salvation Army will provide food and hydration for Moscow and Middletown and will provide hydration for Indianapolis.
